House League Team Sponsorship FAQ's

⇒ **How much sponsorship money is required for our team?**

- \$500

⇒ **Why does our team need a sponsor?**

- The \$500 is used to cover the costs associated with printing the player name and sponsor on each jersey, along with incidental costs such as pictures and the end of year banquet.

⇒ **What if our team has more than one sponsor?**

- Any money collected over \$500 will be returned to the team for their use *less*:
 - \$25 per sponsor for their plaque.
 - \$75 per sponsor (to a maximum of 2 allowed) for each sponsor name on the player jerseys.

⇒ **What if our team can't find a sponsor?**

- You can sponsor yourselves!
 - Plaque fee(s) are optional, one sponsor name for all player jerseys.

⇒ **Where do we send the sponsor money?**

⇒ **Do we have to send all sponsor monies collected to the equipment director?**

- Yes (Gold teams excepted), to ensure:
 - The sponsor receives proper recognition on the Credit Valley Wolves website.
 - The sponsor receives their plaque.
 - The additional setup fee for sponsor names on the player jerseys is covered.

⇒ **What happens after we turn in all our sponsor monies?**

- You will co-ordinate with the equipment director to arrange a time to take the player jerseys in for application of player names and sponsors.
 - You will need to provide a roster via email to the equipment director indicating player number, last name (in all capital letters with the exception of split names, for example De Roche would be De ROCHE), and sponsor name to be applied.
 - Once a date has been set by the equipment director, the clean jerseys must be dropped off at the silk screen location by a team representative.
 - It will take approximately 5 days per team.
- Your sponsor(s) will be posted to the Credit Valley Wolves and MHL web sites.
