If not, **CBET- Coach Stream** certification and **CBET - Development 1** certification *must* be taken before the start of the season. As well, the CVHA requires (and all tournaments require) that at least one member of the coaching staff have at least a *Level 1* Hockey Trainers Certification Program (HTCP) certificate.
